



Students: Having trouble affording groceries?

SNAP may be able to help,
thanks to new rules.



SNAP provides monthly benefits on a debit card that you can use to buy food at grocery stores. **Many more students may now be eligible.**

Low-income students between the ages of 18 and 49 who are enrolled at least half-time in higher education may be eligible if they meet any of the following:

- Students who are eligible to participate in a state or federally financed work study during the regular school year, but who may not be actively participating in work study are still eligible for SNAP.
- Students with an Expected Family Contribution (EFC) of \$0 in the current academic year are also eligible.
